

## Advisory Council

The Middletown Mentor-Intern Program is governed by the Advisory Council. Each member of the Advisory Council is appointed by their bargaining unit. The composition of the Council is as follows:

- Fifty-one percent of the membership is appointed by the Middletown Teachers Association. If possible, the President and the New Teacher Chair of the Association are members.
- Forty-eight percent of the membership is appointed by the Middletown Administrators Association.
- There is one representative from higher education.

### Responsibilities of Council members:

- Attend the monthly meeting, which is held on the fourth Tuesday of the month.
- Serve on at least one committee.
- Report back to your constituency, either at faculty or administrators' meetings or via email.
- Advocate for the Program.
- Represent your constituency, being sure to keep the channels of communication open.
- Support mentors and interns in your building and be able to either answer questions concerning the Program or direct the mentor/intern to the appropriate person for information.
- Support the replacement teacher, including introducing her/him to the staff, providing a place for her/his belongings, and any other assistance she/he may need.
