

# Notice of Vacancy

## School Board Members

The Enlarged City School District of Middletown will conduct its Annual Budget Vote and School Board Member election on Tuesday, May 21, 2019.

Qualified voters of the Middletown School District who are interested in running for a position on the school board may pick up petitions at the office of the School District Clerk at the Board of Education, 223 Wisner Avenue Extension, Middletown, beginning Friday, February 1, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Nominating petitions must be returned to the school district clerk by 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 1, 2019.

In the May 21<sup>st</sup> election, 3 three-year seats must be filled on the nine-member school board.

Qualifications for BOE membership:

- Over 18 years of age as of the date of vote.
- Qualified voter: (US citizen, who has resided within the district for at least 30 days prior to election, and who is not a convicted felon currently serving jail time).
- Able to read and write.
- Resident of the district for one year.
- Cannot be employed by the District.
- Cannot live in the same household with a family member who is also a member of the board.
- May not simultaneously hold another, incompatible public office.
- Must not have been removed from a school district office within one (1) year preceding the date of appointment or election to the Board.
