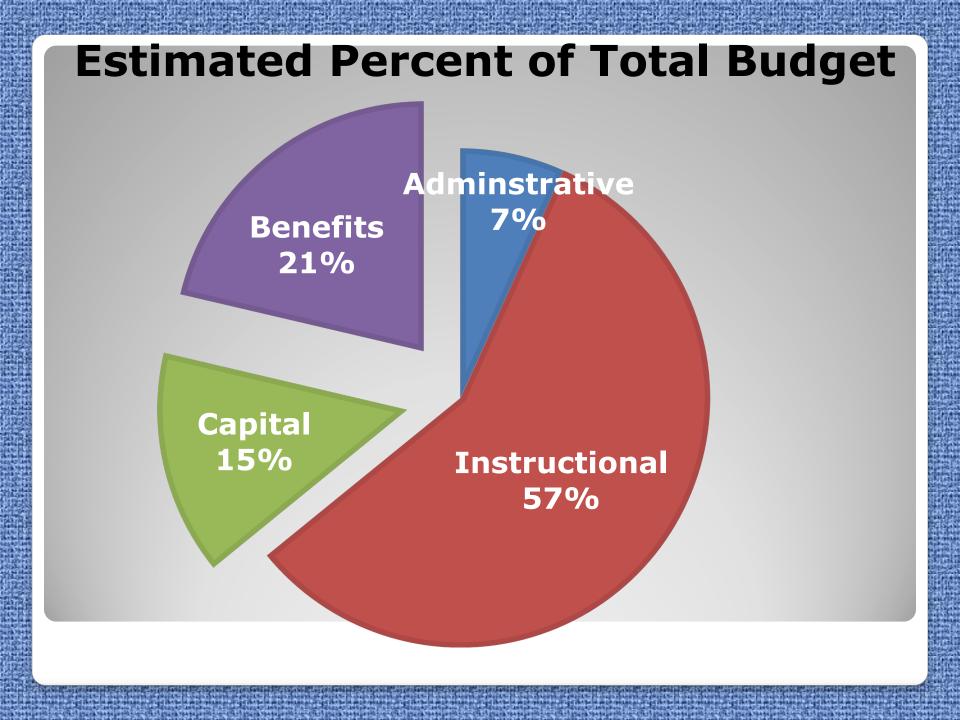

#### **Assumptions for Budgeting**

- **\$ Average CPI rate for most items = 2.0%**
- **\$ Health Insurance Premiums = 6% increase**
- \$ Tax cap maximum = 1.56% (not 2%)
- \$TRS = 10% (estimated)
- \$ERS = 15% (estimated)

#### **Assumptions for Budgeting**

- **\$ BOCES Services Increase = 5% (estimated)**
- **\$ Foundation Aid Increase/Decrease = 0%**
- **\$ Community Schools Increase/Decrease = 0%**
- **\$ Debt Service Payment Increase = 20%**
- **\$ Contractual Salary Increase = \$5M**

- Create new reserve
- May 2021 Vote <u>Proposition #2</u>
- Requires voter approval (50% +1)
- 20 years for \$20 million
