







**Mission Statement**




### **Budget Development Collaboration**






### **Budgeting Assumptions**

## **2023-24 Contingent Budget Rules**

#### **First Vote**

#### **Tuesday, May 16, 2023**

- Budget is below mandated 2% Cap
- Budget passes with 50%+1 positive votes

#### **Contingent Budget**

(If first vote fails)

- Same tax levy as 2022-23
   (\$72,404,150)
- No additional budget requests can be honored
- No equipment purchases except health and safety
- Charge for all facilities use
